

Future of Children Editor in the News

A new report from the Economic Mobility Project, co-authored by *Future of Children* senior editor Isabel Sawhill and John Morton of the Pew Charitable Trusts was released Friday.

The major findings of the study were covered in a *Wall Street Journal* story, which noted the study's conclusion that, "the up escalator that has historically ensured that each generation would do better than the last may not be working very well."

This topic was covered at length in a recent *Future of Children* volume, "Opportunity in America," co-edited by Isabel Sawhill and Sara McLanahan. The accompanying policy brief, *Opportunity in America: The Role of Education*, highlights the ways in which America's education system reinforces the lack of opportunity for children.
